

### **Overall Market Conditions are Difficult...**








### ...but Conditions for Jatropha are Attractive

Investor	Factors
Managers	<ul><li>Shows commitment</li><li>Creates alignment with other investors.</li></ul>
Friends & Family	<ul><li>Disclosure is important.</li><li>Can create conflicts later on.</li></ul>
High Net Worth	<ul><li>Family Offices are large biofuel investors</li><li>Long Dated Inflation linked returns are desirable</li></ul>
Public Markets	<ul> <li>AIM and other similar exchanges are accessible</li> <li>Current market conditions may be difficult</li> <li>NYSE, NASDAQ, LSE, TSE Someday</li> </ul>



### **Funds**

Investor	Factors
Hedge Funds	<ul><li>Prefer liquid investments and short horizons</li><li>but large hedge funds can make exceptions</li></ul>
Venture Capital Funds	<ul><li>Classic funding source for start ups</li><li>Can help start-ups develop, not just investors</li></ul>
Private Equity Funds	<ul> <li>Prefer companies with operating histories</li> <li>Understand cash flow businesses like Jatropha</li> <li>There are a number 'Green' private equity funds</li> </ul>
Real Estate Funds	Jatropha businesses can have a heavy real estate component
	A number of agriculture focused real estate funds have been started



### **Institutions**

Investor	Factors
Banks & Investment Banks	<ul> <li>Many large banks &amp; investment banks have principal investment areas.</li> <li>Can provide advice and services</li> <li>Can also be a source of debt financing</li> </ul>
Insurance Companies & Pension Funds	<ul> <li>Desire long dated, inflation linked returns</li> <li>Green and sustainable is also desired</li> <li>Often invest through funds but many have internal investment groups</li> </ul>



# **Corporations**

Investor	Factors
Energy Companies	<ul><li>Oil companies are already investing in jatropha</li><li>Eventually will have large biofuel operations</li></ul>
Agricultural Companies	<ul><li>Are in biofuels and are investing in jatropha</li><li>Understand the jatropha business</li></ul>
Energy Users	<ul> <li>Airline, shipping and other companies use massive amounts of fuels</li> <li>Green and sustainable has marketing bebefits</li> </ul>



### **Governments**

Investor	Factors
States & Provinces	<ul> <li>Desire to encourage local economic growth</li> <li>Can provide support if not cash capital</li> <li>Land</li> </ul>
Agencies	<ul><li>World Bank, IBRD, etc can provide support</li><li>Debt and project financing</li></ul>
NGOs	<ul><li>Can provide support if not cash capital</li><li>Green and sustainable</li></ul>
